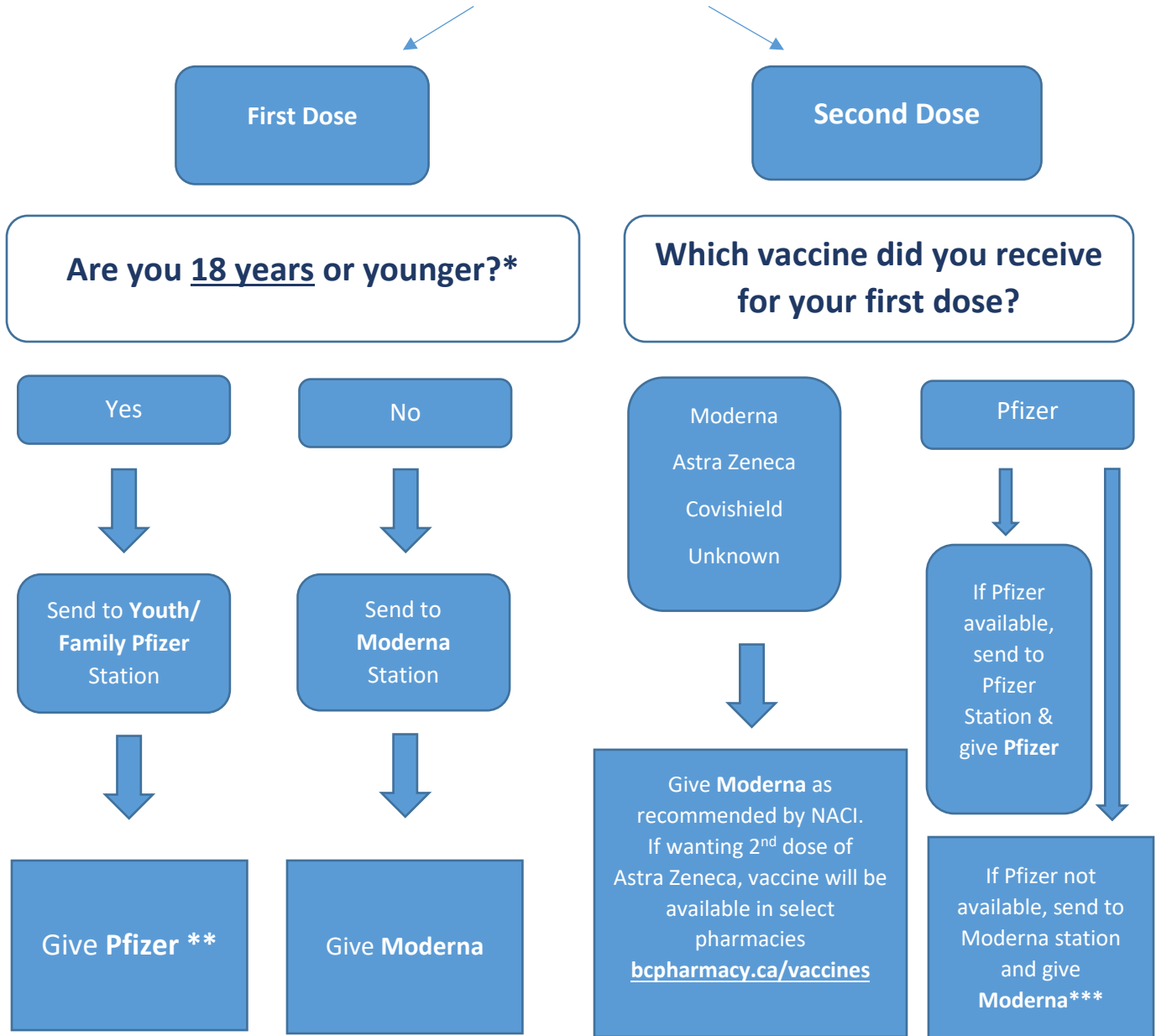


Vaccine Product Eligibility

Are you here for a first or second dose?



- * Per Provincial Health Officer, youth aged 17 turning 18 this calendar year (born 2003) may be offered Moderna with informed consent: This is an off-label use as Moderna is not yet approved by Health Canada for use in those under age 18.
- Clinically extremely vulnerable (CEV) youth aged 16-17 have also been offered Moderna in accordance with provincial guidance. While this was an off-label use, the youth may complete 2nd doses with Moderna or Pfizer.
- ** Pfizer can be offered to those 18 years or younger when presenting to Youth/Family Pfizer station. If Pfizer is unavailable, offer Moderna to individuals 18 years or turning 18 in current calendar year.
- If Pfizer is not available for youth aged 12-17, they will need to be re-booked to a day when Pfizer can be offered.
- *** When the same mRNA COVID-19 vaccine product is not readily available, another mRNA COVID-19 vaccine product is considered interchangeable and should be offered to complete vaccine series.
 - Both mRNA vaccines (Pfizer and Moderna) are equally safe and effective.
