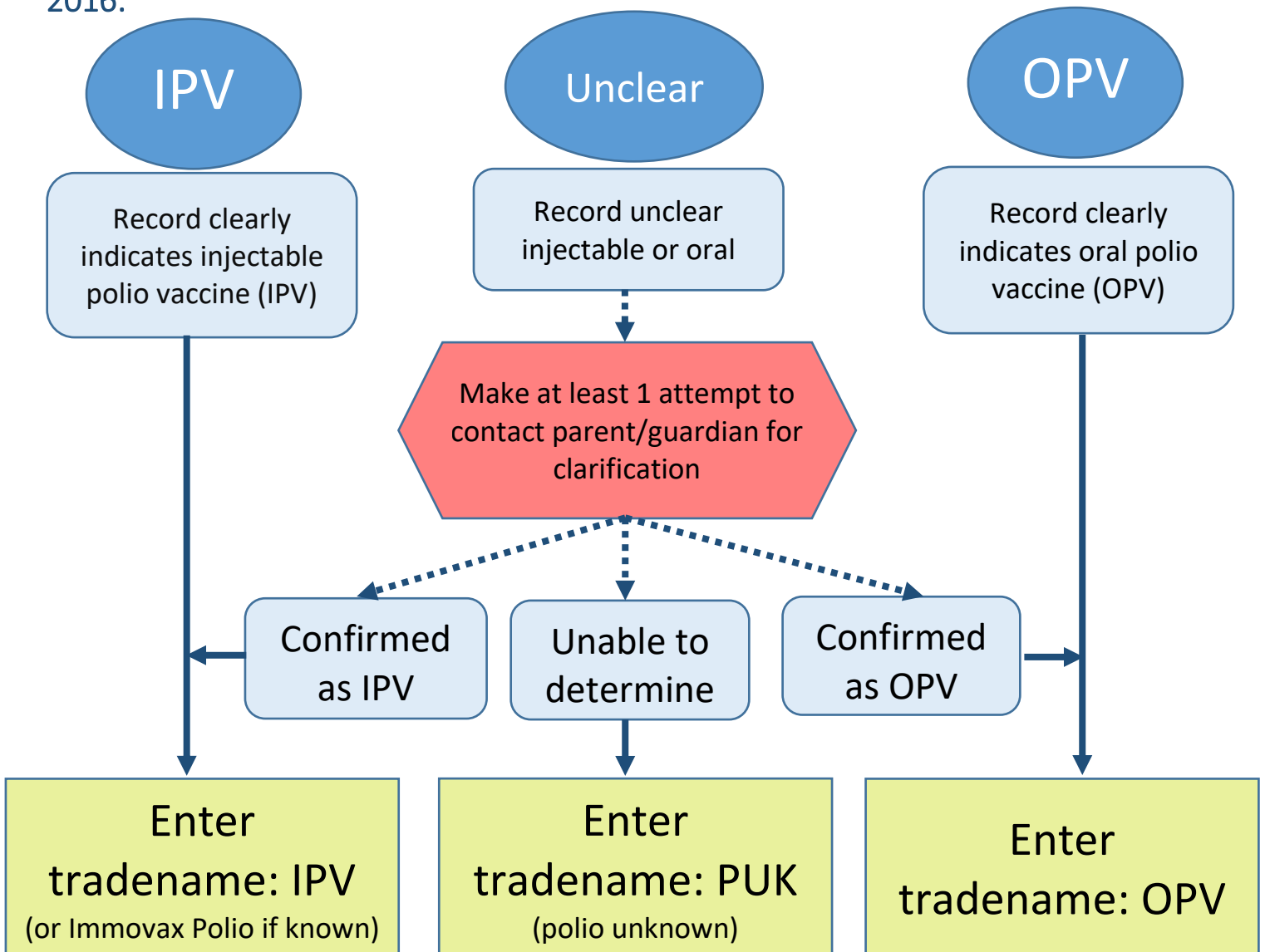


Entering Polio in PARIS Immunization Module

Background: According to the WHO, as of April 2016, trivalent oral polio vaccine (OPV) was replaced with either bivalent or monovalent OPV. In order to ensure protection against all 3 poliovirus types, any doses of OPV received on or after April 1, 2016 are not considered as a valid dose within the routine BC Immunization Schedule.

Action for immunization records containing polio administered on or after April 1, 2016:



PARIS validation: PARIS will **invalidate** all polio doses with tradename “OPV” or “PUK” given on or after April 1, 2016. Doses with the tradename “IPV” or “Immovax Polio” will be processed by the routine rules based on antigen specifications (ex. minimum age, interval, dose number).
